Biographical Sketch: William Madison Anderson, Jr. was born September 20, 1889 in Rock Hill, S.C. to William Madison and Sarah Knott (Latta) Anderson. Anderson, Jr. was educated at Vanderbilt University, Austin College in Sherman, TX, and Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Austin, TX. He was ordained as a Presbyterian minister in 1914, and became pastor of East Dallas Church the same year. During 1915, Anderson served as secretary of schools and colleges of the Presbyterian Church in Texas. William married Nancy Lee Gossett on October 23, 1916, and they had two daughters, Sarah Catherine and Nancy Lee. Anderson became assistant pastor at First Presbyterian Church, Dallas, where his father was pastor, and was chosen as pastor when his father died in 1924. Anderson helped establish the Presbyterian Clinic in Dallas as a charity ministry to babies, and served as a trustee for Austin College. He was instrumental in organizing the Evangelical Theological College, later renamed Dallas Theological Seminary (DTS), and choosing Dallas for the location. He served as Vice President of the school from its founding in 1924 till 1935. He also taught Homiletics about four years at the new seminary and later lectured on pastoral service and practical problems. Anderson died November 11, 1935. A book with nineteen of his sermons was published circa 1948.

### **System of Arrangement:**

The William M. Anderson Sermons are arranged in two series:

**Series I. Published, 1926-1928.** .08 linear ft. (2 file folders) Nineteen numbered sermons.

**Series II. Unpublished, 1926-1932 and undated.** .62 linear ft. (14 file folders) One hundred fifty eight unnumbered sermons and ten excerpts, maintained in the order in which the processor received them. Some are roughly grouped by topic.

**Scope and Content Note:** This collection, housed in sixteen legal size folders in one box, is composed of 177 typed sermons and ten excerpts of sermons by William M. Anderson. The topics covered include God, Jesus Christ, Christ's return, Christian life, salvation, the Bible, communion, and missions. The majority are carbon copies. There are also a few newspaper clippings containing sermon excerpts. Most sermons indicate the date they were preached.

The collection is organized in two series, published and unpublished. The nineteen published sermons are arranged in the order in which they were printed in the book *The Faith that Satisfies: Sermons*. There was not an apparent order to the unpublished sermons, but some on similar subjects are grouped together. The sermon excerpts appear to have been prepared for publication in the newspaper circa 1931-1932.

**Note to the Researcher:** Some of the papers are torn or fragile. See the attached Container List for more details about this collection. When the biblical text for the sermon was indicated, it was included on the Container List. The typist often used letterhead from various businesses or the backs of duplicate legal documents. The size of paper ranges from letter to almost legal.

**Processing Information:** The sermons were originally in six folders, but were divided into sixteen folders to provide better storage conditions for the paper. Because four of the six original files had lists of the contents, the processor did not rearrange them despite the seeming lack of order. Blank paper was used to separate sermons. Newspaper clippings and yellowed or badly torn leaves were replaced by photocopies on acid free paper. The deteriorating originals were discarded.
